In the past several weeks, what have you learned about the love and patience that God expresses throughout the Book of Revelation? How has this study helped you understand God's love for us?

# **Word and Application**

Last week, we saw Jesus' Millennial Reign on earth. We also learned that at the end of the Millennium, Satan is released and makes one last attempt to overthrow Jesus. He is defeated and we see Satan's final punishment, where he is cast into the Lake of Fire, forever! This week we will discuss chapters 21 & 22 that usher in the Great White Throne of Judgment, New Heaven, & the New Earth. We will walk away from these final chapters with the answers of what God wants us to know and what He wants us to do.

1. **Read Revelation 20:11-15.** After the 1000 year Millennial Kingdom comes the Great White Throne of Judgement. This is where our Holy God deals with *unbelievers* and their sin in which there will be *no rewards*. This judgment

is according to their deeds recorded in the **Book of Deeds** for all whose names are *not* found in the **Book of Life,** The very sobering end is second death and the lake of fire for all who stand at this judgement.

How does knowing this information help you understand how to live your life with purpose?

#### 2. Read 2 Peter 3:10.

After the final judgment is made known as to where every soul will spend eternity, God brings His family to their eternal dwelling. The heaven and earth we know of is burned up and replaced when God creates a New Heaven and a New Earth.

God created the universe perfectly and everything was in balance & symmetry, but the devil's deception and humanity's rejection of God's commands, sin entered this universe corrupting the whole thing, but God has a plan! The New Earth and New Heaven have no pain, no sorrow, no tears, and no more death. God has provided a future where all things are perfect. God will crown the Earth with a new city, the New Jerusalem, our Father's House, forever!

How does God's plan bring hope to your life?

3. Read Revelation 21:5, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Revelation 21:6-7, & Revelation 12:11. These verses are not only a description of what God has done to defeat Satan, it describes who you become when you accept the blood of Jesus to cover your sins today, right now. Overcoming is less about what we overcome than who we overcome. Satan uses people, situations, and circumstance in order to tempt us to sin, to cause us to give up and to be defeated.

In contrast, God doesn't want to use you, He wants to know you. God has given us an invitation to know Him in an intimate way. Our response to that invitation is worship. Your new beginning starts the minute you accept Jesus.

What do these above verses say about how to be an overcome and for victory in life?
