This month's discussion is about, "Hearing and Leading through the Holy Spirit".

As you know, we offer a Community series small group at the beginning of each year primarily for 2 reasons:

- 1. To Reach more People and Build more Lives in our church and community.
- 2. To grow together, as leaders and to apply the principles we are learning in our life as a leader.

According to 1 Timothy 3:1 (MSG) God wants us to know that the desire to lead is from God. It states, *"If anyone wants to provide leadership in the church, good!"* Therefore, our desire to lead others is a good thing given to us by God and If our desire to lead is from God, then you can know God will give you what you need to make a difference in the lives of the people you lead.

As a leader, have you wrestled with intimidating thoughts from the enemy that would suggest you are NOT qualified to lead? For instance, some of the lies, the enemy suggests you should believe are:

How can I really make a difference? Why would anyone want to follow me? If they knew my faults they'd never follow me!

If you've had these thoughts, you are not alone and there is a solution to overcoming these lies of the enemy. It is hearing God through His Holy Spirit!

As leaders, this is such an important principle to learn because it helps us to step into a posture of dependence on the Holy Spirit to help us make a difference in people's lives. John 14:26 and 15:26 both tell us that the Holy Spirit is our helper. Therefore, we don't have to rely on our own abilities and strength to lead others well, but we can trust that God will speak through His Holy Spirit to us to help us make a difference.

There are 2 principles we must know if we want the Holy Spirit to speak to us as leaders so that we can make a difference in the lives of the people we lead.

1) "I can't but He can"

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you". Acts 1:8

• On our own, we can only have a limited impact, but with the power of the Holy Spirit working through us, we can make a big difference!

2) "He will use me"

"But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us". 2 Corinthians 4:7

• We are simply human beings, but with the power of God in us, He will use us to make a difference in the lives of people

When you begin to pray for the people you lead in your family, work, small group and dream team, begin to commit these thoughts to the Holy Spirit and trust that you will hear God.
