### Word

Today we are going to look at and discuss the power that God wants to give us through a lifestyle of prayer.

*"Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God." Mark 10:27*

- Why do you think so many people find this verse challenging to live out in their everyday life?

One of the reasons people have a difficult time putting Mark 10:27 into practice is because they don't have a real view of who God is and what He wants to do in our lives.

- How has your view of God limited what He can do in your life?

Mark 11:24 says, *"Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."*

- After hearing this verse how will your view of God and how you approach Him change?

There are many more verses in the Bible that help give us a great perspective on who God is. Romans 10:17 says, *"So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."*

- According to Romans 10:17, what do we need to do to help our faith in God grow?

Not only do we need to get a realistic view of who God is, but we also need to begin to put our faith into action. **Read James 4:2**

- Why do you think we have such a difficult time going to God in prayer instead of trying to make things happen on our own?
- Do you have an example of a time you tried to make something happen on your own only to come up short? What happened when you gave that same situation over to God?

We often strive with our own strength instead of allowing God to do in a moment what is impossible for us to do. God is not a glorified Santa, or lottery machine, but at the same time if we pray and ask we would be surprised what He will do.
