

Chapter 9 How Do I Hear from God?

DISCUSSION POINTS

Two keys to getting over the obstacles preventing us from learning to hear God through His Word:

- 1. Consistency
- 2. Authority

The purpose of the Bible is to show us who God is.

- We want to be close to Him more than we want to memorize information about Him.
- We want to live in a way that honors Him more than we want to prepare for an exam.
- We see our relationship with God as a <u>privilege</u>, not a burden or an obligation.

Two ways of engaging in the Bible:

- 1. Spending personal, one-on-one time with God through studying scripture.
- 2. Spending time studying scripture with others.

What is the greatest challenge you face in trying to hear God through His Word on a daily basis (don't understand, don't have time, etc.)?
How does the Bible impact the way you speak and the way you think? Give a specific example.
Can you think of a specific moral issue where you changed your mind because of what the Bible says? How did it impact your daily life?
