How Do I Hear from God?

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.
~ 2 Timothy 3:16

DISCUSSION POINTS

Two keys to getting over the obstacles preventing us from learning to hear God through His Word:

1. Consistency
2. Authority

The purpose of the Bible is to show us who God is.

- We want to be close to Him more than we want to memorize information about Him.
- We want to live in a way that honors Him more than we want to prepare for an exam.
- We see our relationship with God as a privilege, not a burden or an obligation.

Two ways of engaging in the Bible:

1. Spending personal, one-on-one time with God through studying scripture.
2. Spending time studying scripture with others.
